Beginning at 2:30pm with a procession from St Winefride's Church to the Well, the pilgrimage continues with Holy Mass at 3:00pm, followed by the veneration of the relic of St Winefride and the blessing of the sick. CCO Catholic Christian Outreach – Mission to Cardiff-Menevia. The three-week Diocesan Mission across Cardiff-Menevia starts on 19th June until 5th July. Twelve missionaries will be traveling the diocese to enable us to learn a practical approach to evangelisation called ‘Intentional Accompaniment’, equipping us to walk with others on their

journey of faith. Events are open to all, including Nightfever at Cardiff Cathedral (19th June), a Day of Prayer across the whole Diocese (24th June), a Learn to Pray day at Belmont Abbey (27th June), and a Young Adults Day in Cardiff (5th July). The Missionaries will be at our parishes next weekend! In Aberystwyth there will be something for everyone after the 10:30am Mass: if you're secondary school aged there will be something in the conservatory for about 2 hours. If you're 18 to 35 there will be something lasting about 4 hours in Neuadd Goffa (with lunch) and, for everyone else there will be something in the Church, also lasting for about 2 hours (so parents can take their children home who may be in the other group). It's not often that we get such a large and dedicated group of people coming to our parish to engage with us, so please do make the most of this opportunity by staying after the 10:30 Mass. And, if you normally come to the Saturday Vigil, why not come back on Sunday Morning too for this one-off occasion? If Aberaeron or Lampeter parish is your place of worship, two of the team will be visiting you to speak at the Mass at Aberaeron and, after the 11:00am Mass in Lampeter we hope that many people will choose to say for between an hour and 90mins.

'Behold the Lamb of God' – Day of Prayer in the Diocese On Wednesday 24th June the diocese is holding a day of prayer in parishes and schools. On the morning of that day the Deanery clergy will meet in prayer at the Shrine of Our Lady of the Taper, prior to a deanery meeting. In our own parish that afternoon the school will have a Blessed Sacrament Procession and, from 6:00pm 8:00pm, there will be Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament at Welsh Martyrs with periodic reflections and readings. The evening Mass on that day at Holy Cross Church will be preceded with a Holy Hour.
